MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 5TH MARCH 2019 IN THE OLD
SCHOOL, BOLTON PERCY AT 8.0PM

Minutes of last meeting after previously been circulated to all councillors where signed as correct by Cllr Steele, proposed Cllr Robinson, seconded Cllr Taylor.

CLERKS COMMENTS

- a) **CIL Monies. Defibrillator.** Clerk had received further details of price etc from Ambulance Service. Some of the costs seemed rather excessive, and Cllr Robertson agreed to speak to a contact he has who supplies and fit these items. It was agreed by all councillors Cllr Robertson would send by email the costs involved and could place the order when all councillors agreed by email. It has been decided to purchase two new monitors for both Bolton Percy and Colton as the defibrillator currently sited at the Sun Inn, has out of date parts and will be more difficult to mount in an outside cabinet. Cllr Steele agreed to speak with the Sun Inn and Mr Percival (who purchased it) to explain this action. Siting of the defib's will be on the Parish Room in Bolton Percy and Sun Inn Colton.
First Aid Course. February. 18 people attended and gave a good response. The second course takes place on 9th March.
- b) **Yorkshire Water.** Dates suggested by Yorks Water are not suitable for all councillors, so Clerk trying to arrange a further date.
- c) **The Rampart, Bolton Percy.** It has been confirmed by NYCC that the work upgrading this road will take place w/c 21st August and will take 5 days. Councillors also mentioned Station Road residents cannot be forgotten as they have had no improvement suggested in their area and talks must take place with NYCC to look into this matter.
- d) **School Lane, Bolton Percy.** NYCC Highways have not been able to contact the residents of Lilac House regarding parking. It was also asked if Clerk could arrange a site meeting regarding flooding of this road, footpath outside the latest property to the right side, flooding of Marsh Lane. Clerk to action.

1. **Cycling Events Selby/Tadcaster – May and September.** Cllr Robertson has agreed to put this information of road closures etc on the Parish Council Website.

PLANNING

3. **Saxondale Lodge, Bolton Percy – Amended Plans 2018/1117/FUL.** Proposed erection of a one and half storey single dwelling with integral double garage. Cllrs had no objections to these new plans together with neighbours on each side of the site who are now supporting the application.

4. Land South of Chapel View, Bolton Percy. 2019/0031/FUL. Proposed erection of three detached dwellings. These plans have been re-submitted with no amendments from the original submitted in 2017, and the cllrs felt all their objections still stand. Outside the village development limits, encroaching on to Greenfield land, parking areas at odds with existing properties, and scale of the properties not suitable for this particular site. CPRE have been contacted for their comments. Observation date for submissions to SDC is 18th March.
5. Spinney House, Bolton Percy. 2019/0021/TBA. Application for consent to remove 20 No Ash trees, 2 No Sycamore and 4 No Hawthorn trees. GRANTED
