Clerks Report Action from Last Meeting:

a) Defibrillator Colton: Cllr. Robinson reported that Solar Power for the phone box was not an option and he has had protracted enquiries with Northern Powergrid, Npower and E.ON Etc. with the aim of getting a viable electrical connection for the Defibrillator and is still awaiting a reply from a representative after they have made further investigations into a possible solution.

b) Pumping Station Colton: Cllr. Robertson reported there were no updates on the new Pumping Station, but our Customer Service Contact has been in touch with the Tanker contractors to confirm that quiet pump road tankers should be used on night time pumping.

A resident expressed his concerns over the forthcoming filming in Bolton Percy of the TV program, 'Gentleman Jack', due to Covid risks and asked why the Parish Council had not canvassed residents views and objected to this filming with the influx of traffic and people. It was explained that the PC do not have a right of veto over this and the production company consulted the PC with assurances that all health and traffic management matters will be covered.
