**MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON TUESDAY 1st NOVEMBER 2022
IN THE OLD SCHOOL BOLTON PERCY AT 8.00PM.**

PRESENT: Cllrs. Stewart Steele (Chairman), Kevin Robertson, Andrew Tucker.

APOLOGIES: Cllrs. David Robinson, Mike Nicholls.

MINUTES OF LAST MEETING: Having been previously circulated to all councillors were signed as correct by Cllr. Steele, proposed by Cllr. Robertson, seconded by Cllr. Tucker.

MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC: 3.

1. CLERKS REPORT – ACTION FROM LAST MEETING>

a) Overflying Aircraft – As Stewart Rogerson not present – No update.

b) Yorkshire Water Update – Cllr Nicholls had informed the chairman that investigations are still ongoing.

c) Pump Alley Beck Clearance – This has been completed at the same cost as last year (£500) and Councillors agreed that the invoice be paid from the pump account.

3. PLANNING:

a) FIELD HOUSE< BOLTON PERCY 2022/1160/OUT

As this was briefly discussed at the October meeting and is a resubmission of the previously Rejected application, Cllr. Tucker agreed to contact SDC Planning to reiterate the Parish Councils previous comments.

Cllr. Tucker has also submitted a completed Representation Form for the Selby District Local Plan.

4. FINANCE.

a) Selby District Council have requested early notification of the Parish Precept amount for 2023/24 (because of the merger with NYCC) by 31 December 2022 if possible. It was agreed to discuss this at the next meeting.

5. PARISHIONERS ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

Clerk has had an enquiry from a Bolton Percy resident asking if the Parish Council would be willing to fund 2x Christmas trees (1 for Bolton Percy and 1 for Colton) as last year and also help fund better lighting. Councillors agreed to this, subject to costings.

Dog Bin at Colton – This was ordered from SDC on 25th July, but the order has been lost, so was reordered on 26th October.

A member of the public enquired about Green Garden Waste bins being charged for when SDC is merged with NYCC in 2023. Further information will be sought.
